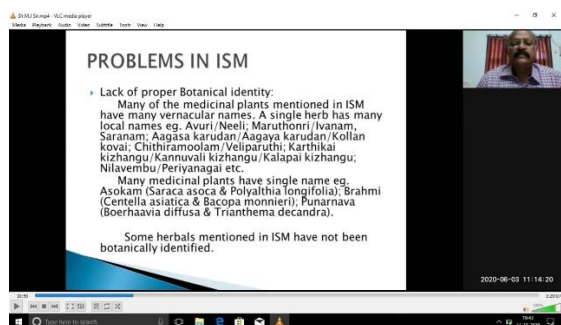

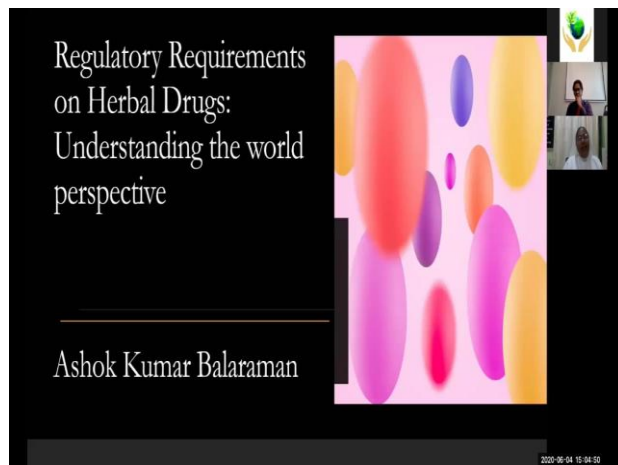
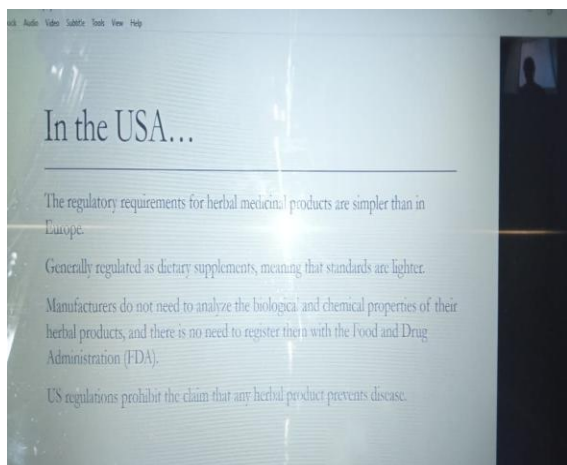
INSTALLATION OF ASSOCIATION

INTERNATIONAL WORKSHOP

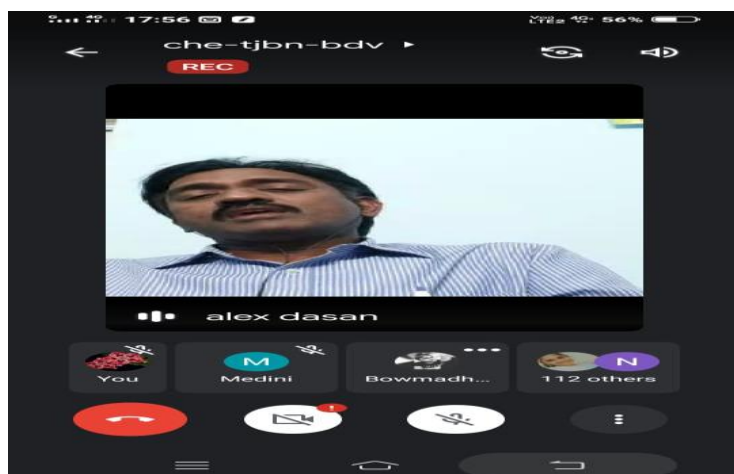

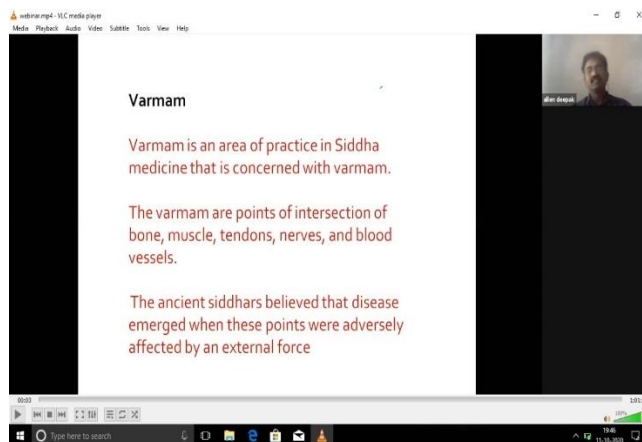
PROLOGUE
