### TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCEMENTS IN MANAGEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTANTS



#### INVITED LECTURE


The Department of Botany oraganized an invited lecture on Women Scientists — An Inspiration was organized on 09.10.2021.

### ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAMME ON HERBAL MEDICINE PREPARATION


