## *About the College*

*Bon Secours College for Women is a gift of God in the higher education ministry undertaken by the Franciscan Sisters of Our Lady of Bon Secours, a Religious congregation which is committed to the welfare of women for decades. The college started its long journey of reaching out to the poor and rural young women in the year 2002 with a meagre strength of 50 students. Now the college has grown in leaps and bounds with a total strength of the 4286 students.*

*The College is affiliated to Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli and recognized by UGC under 2(f) and 12 (B) in 2009 and 2011 respectively. The college is accredited by NAAC with A++ grade (CGPA 3.71) in the second cycle on 13.12.2021.*

*As on 2020-21, under 4 Faculties (Humanities, Commerce and Management Studies, Science & Technology and Computer Studies & Technology), with 18 Departments, the college offers 18 programmes with 4144 students at the undergraduate level, 10 programmes with 381 students at the postgraduate level, 6 students at M.Phil., programme in 5 disciplines and 4 Ph.D., programmes with 23 Scholars. While all the undergraduate and postgraduate programmes are offered under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS), the M.Phil. And Ph.D., programmes are offered under Elective Course System by the Bharathidasan University. There are 170 Diploma Programmes, Add-on and Value Added Courses.*

*The College is located in an area of 16 Acres with 60% greenery and with a built up area of 24993.57 Sq. Mts. The Built up area consists of classrooms, laboratories, Departments, library, administrative office, hostel and Space for support facilities and extension activities. The location of college in a sylvan surrounding provides perfect atmosphere for learning. The campus is calm, peaceful and serene. The plastic free, eco-friendly and clean and green surrounding provides a proper background for the pursuit of knowledge.*

## *About the Department*

*The Department focuses on integration of knowledge, development of critical thinking, problem solving and performance skills. We follow integrated teaching methodology that nurtures a stimulating learning environment to encourage students to learn at higher levels. The delivery methodology is student-centred and includes active learning, inquiry, experimental learning, co-operative and participative learning activities.*

*The Department is committed to the overall development of individual student through academic excellence, professional competence, personal, inter-personal and social skills. The commerce department is designed to equip the students with excellent analytical, conceptual communicative and organizational skills that would facilitate adaptability to any situations.*

*The UG Department of Commerce was established in the founding year itself and upgraded as PG department in 2005 and also started the MBA Concurrent programme, in the year 2010, the department introduced the book bank scheme for economically poor and academically good students. The department was upgraded as a Research Department in 2011 and introduced B.Com (CA), now our department offers B.Com (4 Sections), M.Com, M.Phil, Ph.D., Programmes in Commerce. The department is planning to introduce B.Com (Corporate Secretaryship), B. Com (Bank Management) in near future for the benefit of rural*

students. The Department is built with a good team of 16 committed, eminent and efficient faculties with high credentials to mould the students with the best guidance to excel in all their endeavours. It is a proud achievement of the department in producing continuous University rank holders in B.Com & M.Com programmes which adds laurel to our esteemed institution.

The department aims at the overall development of the students by involving them in Seminars, Conference, Symposia, Workshop, and Cultural Events etc. Guest lecturers are invited to enlighten the students on current topics. Most of the students who have graduated are well placed in various companies in India and overseas and a sizeable number have also taken up further studies.

The department offers 9 add on courses and 2 value added courses in semester pattern in addition to the curriculum for the practical exposure of the students. 20 MOU (16 Industries & 4 Auditors) and 3 linkages were signed by the department. Regularly the students undergo internship training as an industry academic collaboration during the month of July & February. To foster the students towards research, the final year UG, first year of PG students are assigned group projects apart from the curriculum and II PG students do individual project as a part of curriculum. Apart from that our students have undergone training under NAAN MUDHALVAN scheme for various courses.

To enhance the skill and knowledge of the students, the department organises Com-fest, Symposium, Workshop, Seminar, Conferences, Endowment lecture, and Guest Lecture related to the curriculum. Also for the professional development of the faculties, FDP are arranged regularly each year. To inculcate the social responsibility of the students towards the society, Extensions and Outreach activities are conducted in the adopted villages in association with Tamil Nadu Electricity Board (TNEB), Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board (TNWD Board), State Bank of India and India Post.

To mould the students with industrial readiness the department put forward the career counselling, soft skill training, ICT Training to the final year students and also train them to face the global Competencies and fly high. The department also suggest the core sectors of commerce for the campus recruitment of the students and more than 70% of the students placed before they complete their programme.
